July 10, 2024

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

LFL: Joe Bennett reported that everything is good with the LFLs. Royce is still working on repairs on the boxes. He needs to fix the plates on top that have registered serial numbers, etc. on them.

Membership: A membership application from Danielle Bell was received with sponsorship by Daniel Kinnamon. A motion to approve her membership was made by John and seconded by Brad. The vote was unanimous. Diane Burks indicated that Rita Fiorentino, former and founding Executive Director of The Gathering Together, wants to be a member. She will follow-up with Rita.
