Program Update - Jul 17, 2024Andrew Klinger, Plainfield Town Manager



Rotarian Andrew Klinger, Plainfield Town Manager, gave our club his periodic update on what is new in our community.

In no particular order, here is what Andrew shared:

- The new Plainfield Performing Arts Center, known as Hendricks Live is open and has already hosted many events
- The Thomas Little house, an endangered

Indiana Historic Landmark, located on U.S. 40 between Oak Tree Golf Course and Vandalia Blvd., is being moved to the back portion of the lot that it occupies, with the intention of restoring the historic structure

- The Sodalis Nature Park was renamed Echo Hollow Nature Park in April 2024. The Town of Plainfield has enlarged the park and has already begun improvements. The Town is also hoping the receive a \$2.8 million grant from the state to make this local park comparable to some Indiana State parks
- The new Hobbs Station mixed-use development at the NE corner of Smith and Township Line Roads is well into construction, with leasing of its apartments beginning Fall 2024. There will be retail space in the complex, with a Broken Egg restaurant one of the coming occupants. Hobbs Station also has single-family residential homes which are already being sold, and this area will house a senior living center as well
- An Urban Air Trampoline & Adventure Park is coming soon in Plainfield Commons, just south of Buffalo Wild Wings
- The Deer Creek Golf Course has been sold, with its new owner planning to develop an upscale residential community around the golf course.
