Outlined against a blue, gray November sky, Plainfield Rotarians gathered on November 4, 2024 to present a major gift to the Town of Plainfield and its new Civic Center. Your club's gift of this clock, seen above, has been in the planning

stages for at least three years, if not more.

A healthy group of Rotarians, especially in light of the rainy day, was joined by a number of town officials, including Town Manager and fellow Rotarian Andrew Klinger, Town Council President Robin Brandgard, and other members of the Town Administration and the Town Council. Our Club President Brian Culp joined Andrew Klinger and Robin Brandgard in making some formal remarks inside the beautiful lobby of the Civic Center before venturing outside to do the formal ribbon cutting at 11:45 am (note the accuracy of the new clock in the above pictures...). We can all be proud of this lasting and very useful gift to the Town - and since it is an analog clock, perhaps young parents can use our clock to help teach their children how to tell time, not just how to read the time!

Program Update - Oct 30, 2024 Brett Crandall, Co-owner - Brew Link Brewpub





Last week, our weekly meeting hosts, in the person of Brew Link Co-owner Brett Crandall, shared the story of their business and provided a tour of the "backoffice" of the operation, the craft brewery. Brett is one of three owners of Brew Link. His background is from the

restaurant business, but has learned the brewpub/craft brewing along the way. The company was founded in 2015 and is considered a veteranowned business. Brew Link currently brews a variety of wheat beers, stouts, ales (including India Pale Ales), and a porter. They have three locations, the one next to Oak Tree Golf Course where we meet, a location in downtown Indianapolis, at 714 N. Capitol, both under the Brew Link name, and another Plainfield location on Hadley Rd. just west of Quaker Blvd, known as Nigh Restaurant & Brewery. Brett, his partners, and the entire Brew Link staff are very community-minded, supporting many local efforts to make our home an even better place to live. We appreciate their long-standing support of our Annual Night Golf Outing, as well as their efforts to make us feel at home each week during our luncheon meetings.
