PROGRAM NOTES:

Keely Warden introduced our guest, Solomon Curtis, who, inspired by his Uncle Greg Norris' weekend fishing trips became a lifelong outdoorsman and dedicated member of the wildlife community. Throughout his life nature has been his sanctuary, but fishing, in particular, has played a transformative role, saving him during times of hardship. This personal experience has instilled in him a profound appreciation for the healing power of nature and the importance of preserving our natural resources. His passion for hunting and fishing formed a deep connection with the natural world. After experiencing the remote waters of the AEP Recreation Ground, he became hooked on the pursuit of the giant bass, locally becoming known as Bass Curtis.





As the organizer of the annual event Get Kidz HOOKED, he has had the privilege of introducing countless children to the joys of fishing. This event attracts over 350 kids and provides them with the necessary equipment, such as fishing poles and tackles boxes to encourage their continued engagement with the outdoors. In addition, he has journeyed across the state sharing the basics of fishing with less privileged kids, aiming to foster a love for nature and a sense of stewardship. In recognition of his commitment to promoting angling and environmental education, he was honored to represent the state as a Fishing Ambassador. This prestigious role has afforded him the opportunity to mentor children in outdoor activities, inspiring them to embrace the outdoors and develop a strong conservation ethic.

Through his YouTube channel, he has been able to extend his reach and share his knowledge and experiences with a wider audience. He presented at the Ohio Fishing Expo where he had the privilege of revealing his secrets to catching giant bass. He has been featured in numerous publications across the state including the #1 fishing magazine in the country, Bassmaster magazine.

After Graduating from Ohio University, Solomon believed his purpose was serving others and trying to make a difference in at-risk youth. One of his favorite quotes is from Rita Pierson, "Every Child deserves a champion- an adult who will never give up on them". He did exactly that by working with youth and mentoring them for the last 25 years via Child Protective Services, the Lelia L. Peyton Counseling Center, and Foxfire Schools. Currently he serves as the director of student and transitional services at Foxfire High School where he has been for the last 8 years. Due to his relentless efforts, advocacy, & outstanding contributions to youth, he was awarded the Child & Youth Care Professional of the Year.
