PROGRAM NOTES

There is a multi-year fundraising campaign to raise six million dollars to build a new Hospice Building that will house all hospice staff and include new inpatient rooms. The new facility will be on the corner of Ashland and Forest, across from the current inpatient building which was built in 1987. The new facility will face Ashland Ave. The new building will include some of the best items from the old, such as the stained-glass windows. There are naming opportunities, and any donation amount is welcome. Pebbles explained the difference between Palliative care where the focus could still be pursuing treatment and Hospice care where the focus of care is dignified comfort. Many in the audience shared personal stories of how the Genesis Hospice staff has cared for a family member and how grateful they were that there was a full-service Hospice program in Zanesville. Kelly referenced the recent article in the Zanesville Times Recorder and how it prompted several generous donations.
