Pebbles explained the difference between Palliative care where the focus could still be pursuing treatment and Hospice care where the focus of care is dignified comfort. Many in the audience shared personal stories of how the Genesis Hospice staff has cared for a family member and how grateful they were that there was a full-service Hospice program in Zanesville.
