Introduction by Brian Wagner. The planned speaker cancelled and two of our members agreed to fill in. Keely Warden spoke about Christ's Table. She began by thanking Daybreak members for volunteering this week. She started in Rotary fourteen years ago when she took over at Christ' Table. It was a requirement but has served to be one of her greatest opportunities to meet new, long last friends. Christ's Table served 114 thousand meals in 2024 and 3.6 million since opening in the 1980s. Some of the programs that they offer besides serving a mid-day meal include: Food Resource where they pick up food from the big box stores and distribute it among the twelve food pantries and other meal programs throughout the county, With their Homebound Meals they deliver around 250 meals every day in the City of Zanesville. They use volunteers that donate their time and gas to make those deliveries. These services do not duplicate what the Senior Center does. The receive referrals from medical providers for this service.



They work with Jobs and Family Services and the city and county courts by having people volunteer there. They learn how to perform jobs duties and other skills to make them more employable. Keely spoke about a particular permanent employee that is there that came from these programs and now has a family and is purchasing a home.

Dylan Parry from Lepi & Associates Real Estate Services spoke about joining Care Source when Brad Lynch invited him. He is a past president and currently serves as Assistant Governor of District 6690. He went around to each table asking a trivia question on the previous presentations and provided a sway bag for those who answered correctly.
