Danny grew up in Philo with his mom/stepdad, brother and sister. He loved playing sports and baseball was his favorite, which lead him to play some college ball. He started working at 14 on a farm and at 22 he started working in a steel mill where he worked for 15 yrs, eventually running the biggest steel mill in the United States. He worked in manufacturing various leadership positions until 2024 when he felt God calling him elsewhere, so in October of 2024 he started working at Forever Dads.



Celebrate Recovery is a 12 step program sponsored by North Terrace Church.

Each Monday night a group of people experiencing a wide range of hurts, habits, and hang ups gather for a meal and for mutual encouragement, accountability, and support and discovering that God is there for them in powerful ways. Many are finding sobriety and healing through the love and support of God and others.
