PRESENTATION: The club welcomed Dr. Cousins, a cardiothoracic surgeon with MHS. Dr. Cousins presented an overview of his upbringing (11th of 11 children, born and raised in a tiny town in West Virginia, dad was a coal miner for 37 years), and education (medical education was at the University of Michigan). He then highlighted numerous exciting happenings with Memorial Health System from Women's and Children's Hospital to the Pediatric Emergency Room, the partnership with the Mayo Clinic, and the robotic surgery capabilities. From there he described how heart surgery is a team sport that involves 14 different disciplines, and how, when he came here a year ago from Camden Clark, he brought his whole team with him. From there, Dr. Cousins discussed various technical aspects and surgeries for cardiovascular disease and talked about his specialty, Beating Heart Cardiovascular Surgery. The club then had plenty of time to ask questions. Jackie Minor put it best, "I've heard dozens and dozens of speeches from doctors and hospital staff, but this was the most enjoyable and easy to understand presentation I've ever heard from MHS.", and she was 100% right! Humorous, down to earth, and incredibly knowledgeable, Dr. Cousins gave us an excellent program.
