- Approved an additional \$2,000 from the district grant to be used this year toward scholarship grants - creating a grand total of \$20,000 to be given in Rotary scholarships this year.
- Approved \$2,000 from the district service project budget to support the Soles4Souls 4EveryKid initiative which aims to provide new shoes for kids in need across the state of Ohio.
