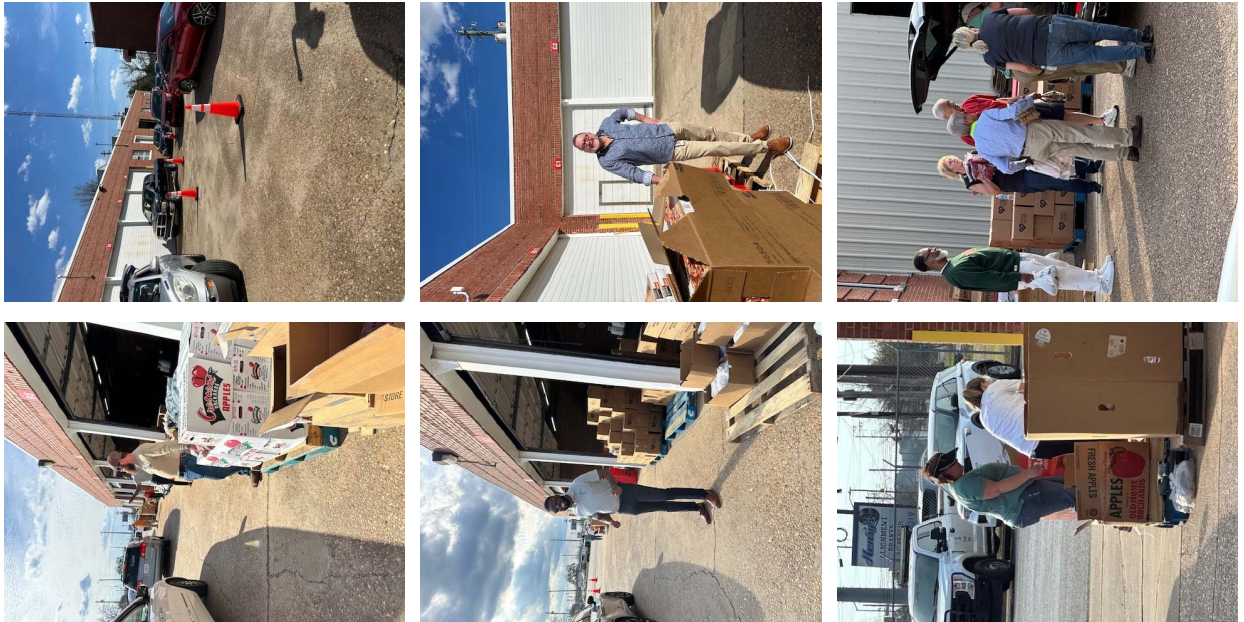
3/4 Meeting Recap

As a minister of teaching, certified trainer, and minister of the Gospel, Brackins' passions are teaching, learning and traveling, to fulfill her life's mission of empowering minds and elevating lives.
