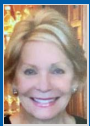

Board Meeting

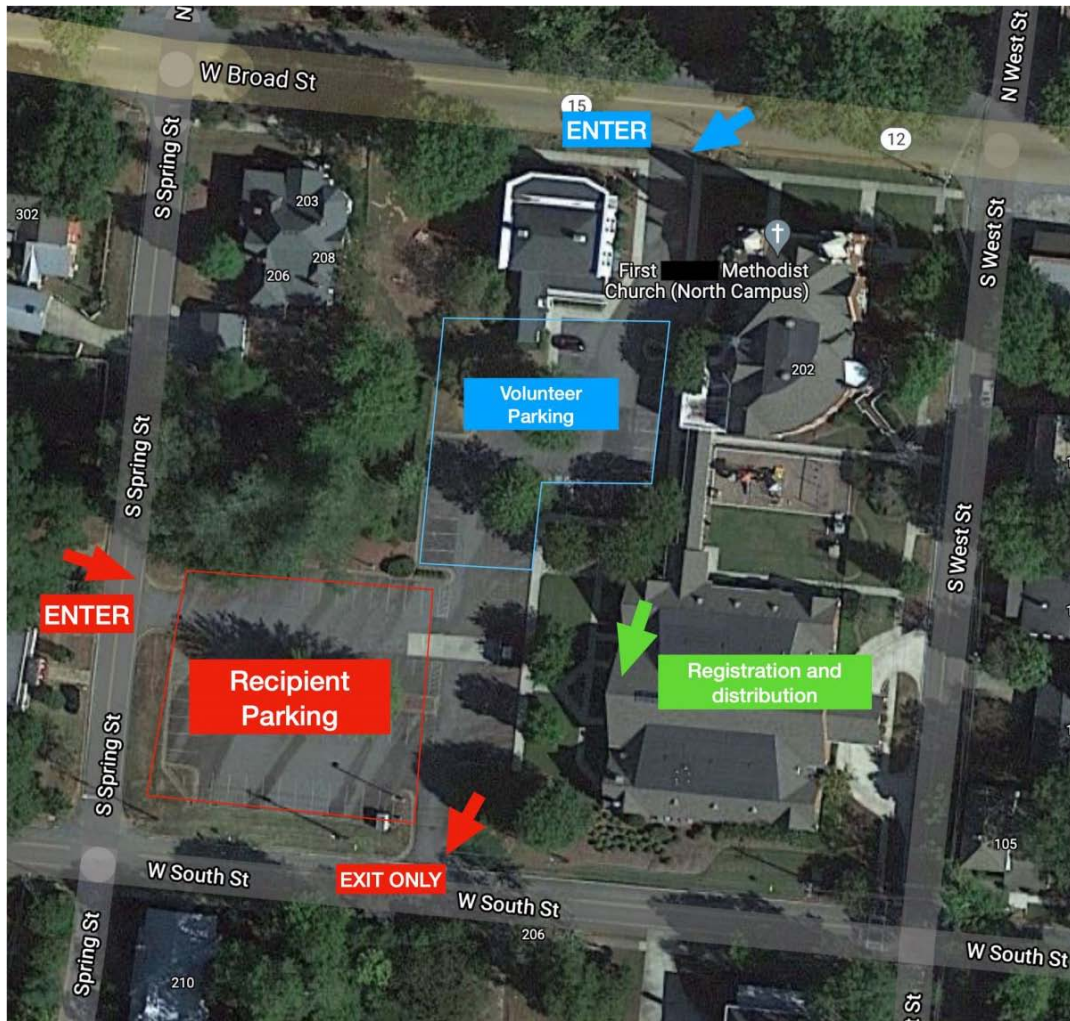
