### Featured Speaker - Hellen Levy Georgia Rotary Student Program (GRSP) Student Ambassador



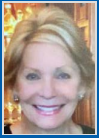

## Rotary Foundation - Doing Good in the World



### Teaching peaceful problem-solving in Israel

**Area of focus:** Promoting peace

**Host sponsor:** Rotary Club of Haifa, Israel

**International sponsor:** Rotary Club of Coral Springs-Parkland, Florida, USA

**Total budget:** \$161,750

**Background:** Israel faces challenges with water scarcity and ongoing conflict.

**Scope:** This water project has a "hidden" peace component: Water challenges form the basis of a science curriculum that helps schoolchildren from different

backgrounds in Haifa find solutions peacefully and creatively.

**Impact:** Students from 10 schools worked together to present 38 science projects focused on water and sanitation. One project involving students from three schools won first prize in a national competition. Schools also participated in 15 cross-cultural activities.

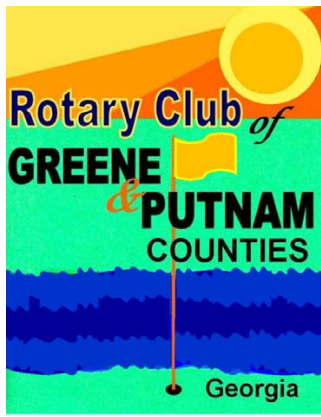
