Rotary District Governor Visit Bobby Hildreth, Morgan County Rotary

Hildreth joined the Morgan County Rotary Club in 2018 after transferring from the 75-member Rotary Club of Thomson. He served as 2015-2016 president of the Thomson club where his accomplishments include achieving 100% Paul Harris Club, district Gold Level club award, and the District 6910 R.L. Panyik Leadership Award for Large Clubs. At the district level, Hildreth served as Area IX Assistant Governor from 2016 through 2018. As Assistant Governor he was awarded the 2016-2107 District Governor's Excellence Award for Assistant Governors. Hildreth's district leadership experience also includes two years as District Membership Co-Chair providing leadership in club member growth and retention. In his home club, Hildreth is the club Foundation Chair and restarted the club's sponsorship of the Rotary Youth Leadership Award (RYLA) program. Hildreth was also awarded the Morgan County Rotarian of the Year Award in 2019-2020 and 2021-2022.



Hildreth is a graduate of the Rotary Leadership Institute (RLI), a Paul Harris Fellow, member of the Paul Harris Society and a GRSP Will Watt Fellow. Hildreth retired after 41 years of service with Georgia Power, serving in various leadership positions in transmission system operations, customer service, and area distribution and business office operations management. He previously served as board chairman of the Thomson McDuffie County Chamber of Commerce and the Macon County Chamber of Commerce. Hildreth also served on the city council in the City of Montezuma and one year as Mayor Pro Tempore. Hildreth is originally from Columbus where he met and married his high school sweetheart, the former Gail Vinyard. They have two grown children and four grandchildren.
