## Tuesday, January 7th, 2025 - Post Election Analysis, Dr. Bullock



Come and hear from our very own, Dr. Bullock, about the 2024 election and political landscape. Charles S. Bullock, III, holds the Richard B. Russell Chair in Political Science and is Josiah Meigs Distinguished Teaching Professor and University Professor of Public and International Affairs at the University of Georgia. He has been at the University of Georgia since 1968, with the exception of two years when he was a Professor of Political Science at the University of Houston. In 2005 and 2009, he was a senior fellow at Oxford University's Rothermere American Institute.

In 2015, Dr. Bullock was named University Professor, an honor bestowed on faculty who have had a significant impact on the University of Georgia beyond normal academic responsibilities.

Bullock is author, co-author, editor or co-editor of 40 books and more than 250 articles and book chapters. He has published in major political science, public administration and education journals. Among his most recent books are *Redistricting: The Most Political Activity in America*, 2nd edition, (2021); *The Changing Political South: How Minorities and Women are Transforming the Region*, co-authored with Susan A. MacManus, Jeremy D. Mayer and Mark J. Rozell, (2024); *African American Statewide Candidates in the New South*, co-authored with Susan A. MacManus, Jeremy D. Mayer and Mark J. Rozell, (2022); *The New Politics of the Old South*, 7<sup>th</sup> edition, co-edited with Mark Rozell, (2022); *Special Elections: The Backdoor Entrance to Congress*, co-authored with Karen Owen (2021); *The South and the Transformation of U.S. Politics*, co-authored with Susan MacManus, Jeremy Mayer and Mark Rozell (2019); Ronald Keith Gaddie. 2018; *The Rise and Fall of the Voting Rights Act*, co-authored with Ronald Keith Gaddie and Justin J. Wert. 2016; *The Three Governors' Controversy-Skulduggery, Machinations and the Decline of Progressive Politics in the Peach State*, co-authored with Scott E. Buchanan and Ronald Keith Gaddie. 2015. Bullock is the only four-time winner of the V.O. Key Award for having written the best book on southern politics published in a particular year.

Bullock's teaching and research specialties are legislative politics and southern politics. He has been recognized for outstanding teaching by the Department of Political Science, the Honors Program, and the Student Government Association. In 1993, Bullock was one of four professors in the College of Arts and Sciences to receive its highest teaching award. He was the initial winner of the outstanding professor in the School of Public and International Affairs. In 2005 he won the University of Georgia's highest teaching award.

Bullock is a regular source for journalists interested in understanding the politics of the South and Georgia. *Georgia Trend* has included Bullock among its lists of Most Influential Georgians and Notable Georgians.

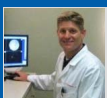
