Rotary members have the opportunity to develop new skills and may ask to visit Toastmasters clubs or receive evaluations. Toastmasters has also developed eight educational courses for Rotarians and Rotaractors, available on Rotary International's Learning Center, which can be accessed by members in nine languages.

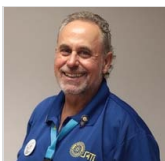

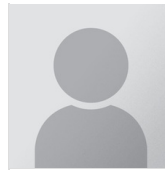
