When Dad 'again' completed a residency in medicine & surgery we moved to Western New York. That is where my first memories of being a 'Brat' occurred. Admittedly, I started a fire in a sofa and was rescued by the Fire Department. When my twin sisters were born I tried to sell one of them; I did refuse an offer! We lived in Pavilion NY (south of Rochester) where Dad was a 'Country Doctor' in our home as the only physician in the area. Being in this rural setting I learned many agricultural activities such as birthing animals, milking cows & baling hay. Snow was an annual event with 80"-100" annually; now snow is great to visit and greater to leave! I went to an Episcopalian High School in Niagara Falls NY. Memories there include seeing 'black snow' caused by the chemical plants, 'lettering' in three sports each year and earning the 'Sacred Studies' award in 1965.




