## Member Spotlight Harry Heuman



My parents and I immigrated to the USA from Germany in March 1947 when I was less than a year old. My parents were Holocaust Survivors who were glad to 'restart' their lives. When Dad 'again' completed a residency in medicine & surgery we moved to Western New York. That is where my first memories of being a 'Brat' occurred. Admittedly, I started a fire in a sofa and was rescued by the Fire Department. When my twin sisters were born I tried to sell one of them; I did refuse an offer! We lived in Pavilion NY (south of Rochester) where Dad was a 'Country Doctor' in our home as the only physician in the area. Being in this rural setting I learned many agricultural activities such as birthing animals, milking cows & baling hay. Snow was an annual event with 80"-100" annually; now snow is great to visit and greater to leave! I went to an Episcopalian High School in Niagara Falls NY. Memories there include seeing 'black snow' caused by the chemical plants, 'lettering' in three sports each year and earning the 'Sacred Studies' award in 1965. I graduated from Illinois Wesleyan University (Sociology & Political Science) in 1969. Thereafter I obtained a Master in Urban Planning from the College of Architecture at Texas A&M University. My career path of over 40 years in managerial and executive positions was with County Planning agencies in Troy NY, Riverside CA, Monterey CA, Rockford, IL, Joliet IL and finally Tampa FL. During my years in Monterey I had long hair, a beard, drove an orange & white VW Bus and admit to .....! I retired in 2012 and established H3 Development Solutions to assist clients with their land development issues. I have been and am a Board member of various organizations. The one I will never do again is being President of my Condo! I joined Rotary over 20 years ago in D6890 where I served in Club & District positions. Now I am happily in the best Club in D6950! Additionally, I am active with the Florida Holocaust Museum and Congregation B'nai Israel. I have two wonderful children, six awesome grandchildren and two beautiful great grandchildren. My Sweetheart & Partner Lourdes (one of our newest members) has one child and two grandchildren. She and I always enjoy time with family (especially the 'grands'), new adventures, new eateries, outdoor activities, Beer Stein contests (Inquire about details) and relaxing together.
