I was a Surface to Air Missile Fire Control Technician for two years. When I left the military I moved to the St. Petersburg, FL area where my parents had moved after retirement, I lived in Redington Shores for several years where I met my future wife, Maureen, on the beach and in 1964 we were married and moved to Seminole. 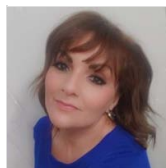

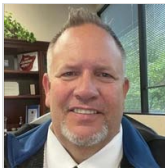
