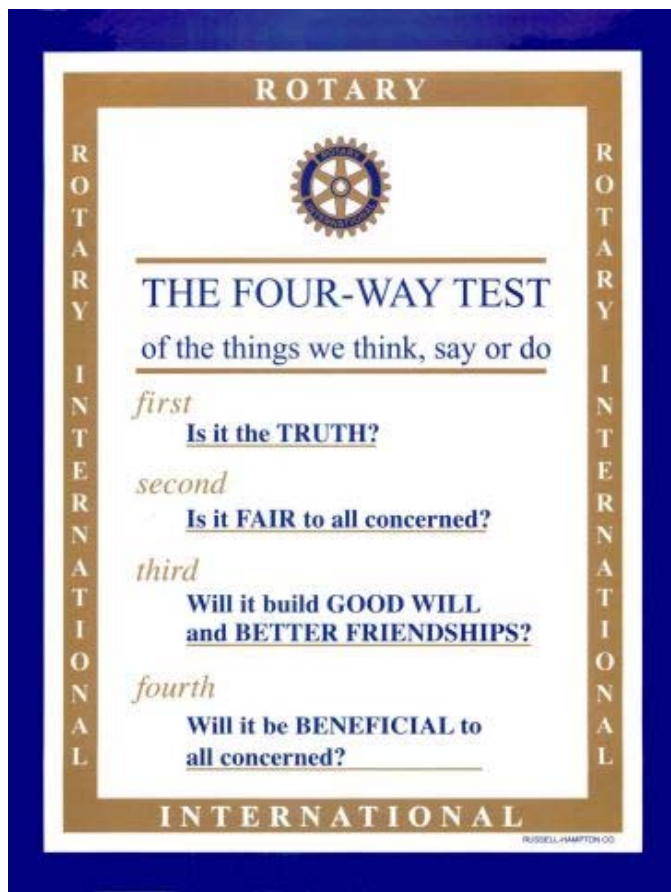
Why: Let's celebrate the success of our Kentucky Derby fundraiser & enjoy club fellowship!

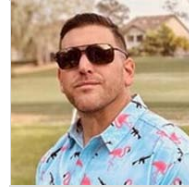
