Andrea Martone, a consultant for Selah Freedom, shared insights on the organization's efforts to combat sex trafficking, emphasizing the importance of rehabilitation for victims and the differences between sex trafficking and prostitution. She highlighted the alarming statistics surrounding the issue, including the average age of victims and the role of social media in recruitment. The meeting concluded with a discussion on the organization's programs, the need for community support, and the transformative success stories of survivors.

Andrea encouraged attendees to become advocates within their communities, spreading awareness and fostering environments where victims feel safe to seek help.

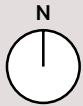
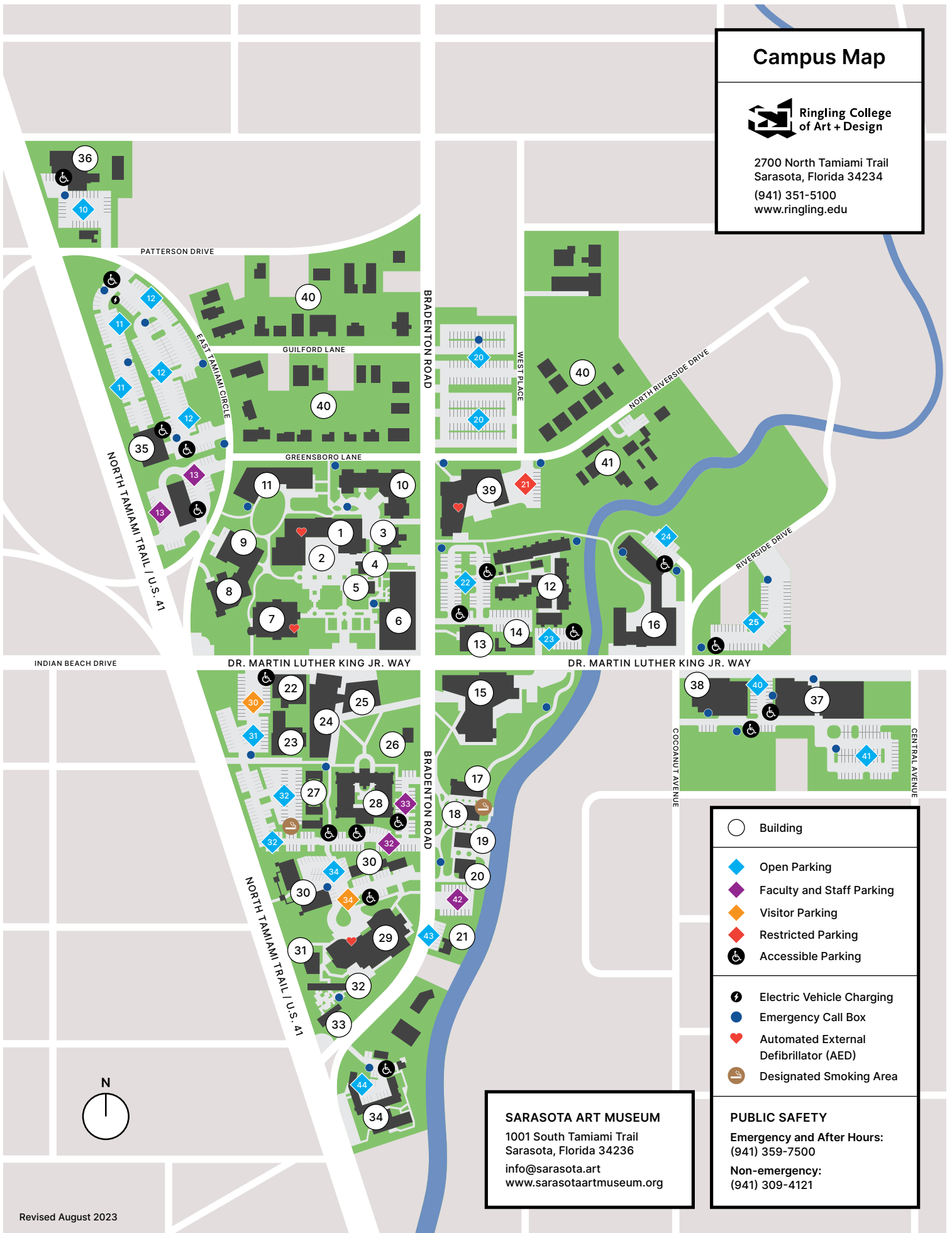
