Our speaker today is Bob Klettner, who told us about barbecue judging. Bob belongs to the Kansas City Barbecue Society (KCBS). Recognizing barbecue as America's cuisine, the mission of the Kansas City Barbecue Society is to celebrate, teach, preserve and promote barbecue as a culinary technique, sport and art form. The KCBS organizes events, teams and judges. Events will have classes, awards, championships and banquets. Team contest rules and regulations are set by the KCBS. Judges, representatives and organizers are established by the KCBS. The KCBS has a foundation, outfitters and partnerships with vendors and other organizations. The main classes of barbecue are chicken, ribs, pulled pork and brisket. The barbecue is judged on taste, tenderness and appearance. Typically, a judge will taste six entries for each of the four classes of meat. A couple of Bob's favorite BBQ restaurants are Mission BBQ in Oviedo and Kellers BBQ in Altamonte Springs.
