Rotary Club of the Villages Noon looks forward to Fire Prevention Week every October. For the last 8 years, the Rotary Noon members have distributed personalized fire safety books to first graders attending four different elementary schools. Approximately 500 books were distributed in 2023! It is a great way, for the mostly retired members of Rotary Noon, to positively engage with the community. RCV Noon has no trouble soliciting volunteers for these distribution events, as reading to the excited children is a heartwarming experience. Last fall 22 Rotarians signed up for multiple classroom visits (102 service hours). The "Magic of Rotary" begins when the students receive their own books, personalized with their very own name, as the main character of the story. The positive impact is that for some children, this is the only book they own. Seeing their name in print throughout the book ignites their excitement. Most classrooms conclude the experience by taking a picture of the class with the teacher and the Rotarians. Posters are then made and returned to the school. Traditionally visits from the local fire departments are scheduled for after the readings. Now that is "Magic"



The Rotary Club Of Orlando and its Foundation have collaborated in helping The Salvation Army, serving Orange and Osceola counties purchase a trailer to assist victims of disasters or emergencies.

Salvation Army Area Commander, Major Ken Chapman, said, "the trailer will provide showers, rest room and laundry facilities for those in need. We are so grateful to the Rotary Club and its Foundation for their very generous support that made that made this important community asset a reality."

The trailer is 28 feet long and includes three showers/restrooms, with one being ADA accessible, and two washers and driers that can be moved to impacted areas.

Rotary Club President, Dan Bone, said, "Rotary is proud to be apart of this community, our goal is to serve in large and small ways and this trailer is just one example of how we serve."

Sandra Woodall, President of the club's foundation explained, "our club members work hard to generate funds for the foundation so this kind, and many other, community service projects can become reality."
