





BXRC The Rotary Foundation Campaign

Annual fund goal: \$20,000 YTD: \$14,536 73% met

Polio Plus goal: \$3600 YTD: \$2,650 76% met

Other: \$100 Endowment Fund: \$16,500 Although we're on track to make our goals, our member participation is narrower than last Annual Fund. We have 12 Sustaining members (those who give \$100 per year). We have 57 members total. A gift of \$10 per month via Rotary Direct to the annual fund would give you more than enough points to be a Sustaining member. You can also give your contribution checks to **Dave**, our Club Foundation Chair, but Rotary Direct is easy to set up automatic payments.
