

BXRC The Rotary Foundation Campaign

Annual fund goal: \$20,000 **YTD:** \$15,293.94 **76% met**

Polio Plus goal: \$3600 YTD: \$3,107 86% met

Other: \$100 Endowment Fund: \$16,750 Although we're on track to make our goals, our member participation is narrower than last Annual Fund. We have 12 Sustaining members (those who give \$100 per year). We have 57 members total.
