## WNC DUI Task Force gives a voice to DUI victims



Ellen Pitt and Trooper Gass updated Rotarians on the work being done by the WNC Regional DUI Task Force during the Feb. 18 meeting of the Rotary Club of Franklin Daybreak. Pitt encouraged Rotarians to support House Bill 108 which would lower the legal alcohol limit for operating a motor vehicle to .05. Currently, the legal blood alcohol limit in North Carolina is .08. The WNC task force team provides unique crime victim services, officer support, and non-governmental oversight

into the courts.
