# Reminder!



# A Reminder on How to Check Up on Current Opportunities and How to Sign Up Anytime (3 Options)

- 1. Use Volunteer Sign Up Site on the internet
  - a. Link is <u>www.volunteersignup.org/KDMK3</u>.
  - b. You will now see all the volunteer events that are currently available.
  - c. Choose the event which you would like to volunteer. Make sure you have selected the correct event, date, and time.
  - d. Move the cursor to the green arrow on the right side of your chosen event and click on it.
  - e. You will be asked for: last name, first name, your email address, and your phone number. Now check the green box at the bottom of the screen: "Agree and Sign Up"
  - f. You will see SUCCESS! You are now signed up for the event.
- 2. A clip board will be available at our meetings (passed around the tables) for you to indicate an event you would like to be a volunteer.
