Rotary Club of Belmont

A Century of Service Above Self 1925 - 2025

Sometime prior to Aug. 25, 1925 - Arch Lineberger, Henry Jordan and Harley B. Gaston were invited to attend a meeting of the Gastonia Rotary Club, and as a result of that meeting, came home and undertook the organization of the Belmont Rotary Club.

Aug. 25, 1925 - John R. Rankin was appointed to help organize a Rotary Club in Belmont as a special representative of District Governor Fred Kent of Asheville.

Oct. 8, **1925** - Rotary International President Donald A. Adams notified Harley B. Gaston of his appointment as Chairman of the Organizing Committee for the Rotary Club of Belmont.

Nov. 24, 1925 - First organizational meeting held for the proposed Belmont Rotary Club.

Dec. 14, 1925 - Belmont Rotary Club elected into membership by Rotary International as Club No. 2182, sponsored by Gastonia Rotary Club. Today, there are more than 46,000 Rotary Clubs worldwide.

Jan. 11, 1926 - The Charter for the Rotary Club of Belmont was officially presented to the club by District Governor Fred Kent and John R. Rankin at a dinner in the Baptist Tea Room of the Davis Building.
