### President Ken Reports on Rotary 2025-26 plans

Belmont Rotary Club President Ken Pahon updated members after participating in several days of training in preparation for the upcoming Rotary year.

President Ken Pahon briefed club members after spending three days in Greensboro recently with about 500 fellow Rotarians preparing for the next Rotary year which begins on July 1.

He reported that the next governor of Rotary District 7680 will be Donna Moffett of the Rotary Club of North Mecklenburg and that Governor Moffett will make her official visit to the Belmont Club on August 6. And, he said, the theme for Rotary in 2025-26 will be "Unite For Good."

Reminding members that the celebration of the 100th anniversary of Belmont Rotary Club continues throughout 2025, Ken said the club will have a booth highlighting the

centennial at Belmont's Garibaldi Festival this spring in Stowe Park, and plans are being made for hosting a reception in September with the Montcross Area Chamber of Commerce and a banquet in October for club members and guests.

More service projects, including joint projects with other clubs, a pickleball tournament to raise funds for scholarships, and membership growth will be among Ken's goals for the coming Rotary year.

He reminded members of the District Rotary Conference in Statesville on May 2 and 3, and encouraged members to attend. Ken also urged members to download a new phone app providing a wide range of information and conveniences for Rotarians.
