President Ken Pahon briefed club members after spending three days in Greensboro recently with about 500 fellow Rotarians preparing for the next Rotary year which begins on July 1.

He reported that the next governor of Rotary District 7680 will be Donna Moffett of the Rotary Club of North Mecklenburg and that Governor Moffett will make her official visit to the Belmont Club on August 6. And, he said, the theme for Rotary in 2025-26 will be "Unite For Good."

Reminding members that the celebration of the 100th anniversary of Belmont Rotary Club continues throughout 2025, Ken said the club will have a booth highlighting the
