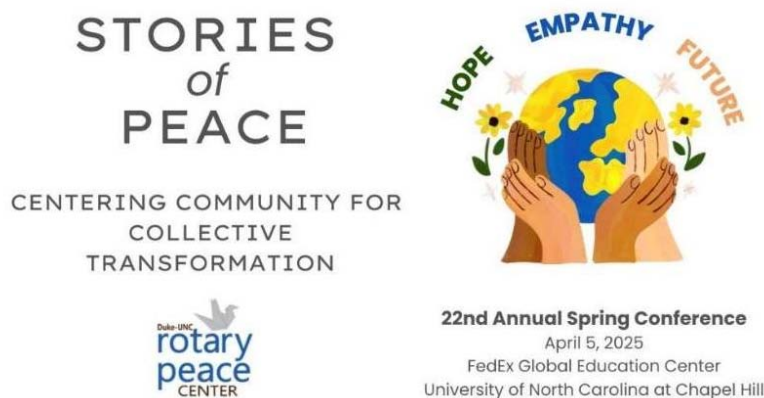

## Rotary Club of Raleigh 7-Day Forecast

Make sure to do a weather check before driving home this evening as severe storms are expected across the Raleigh metro anywhere from 5PM to 9PM. Damaging wind gusts will be likely with these storms with a smaller possibility of tornadoes and large hail. Be weather-aware, check your phone for alerts, and make sure you and your loved ones have a severe weather communication plan. The silver lining to these storms is that some of that lovely yellow powder that covers everything outdoors will be cleared away by tomorrow morning!

Lingering showers and storms will be possible overnight and into Tuesday morning. Tuesday will be a beautiful spring day in NC with high temperatures around 70F and sunny skies. Except for a slight chance of showers overnight Wednesday, the rest of the work week looks to be mostly sunny/clear. Daytime high temperatures will climb each day and reach a high of near 90F on Friday. Overnight low temperatures will mirror this increase with temperatures around 70F at sunrise on Friday. Another round of precipitation is expected over the weekend. It's too soon to nail down a specific time when rain will impact the region, but expect mostly cloudy skies and scattered showers for Saturday and Sunday. Temperatures will remain above normal with highs in the mid-80s and lows in the mid-60s for both Saturday and Sunday.
