

RCOR 7-Day Forecast

This week will include roller-coaster temperatures and a mid-week chance of severe weather. Today will be another chilly but clear day with high temperatures barely making it to 50F. There will be another chance of below-freezing temperatures again tonight with lows around 32F expected near sunrise on Tuesday. Tuesday and Wednesday will be warmer with high temperatures near 70F. Right now, it looks like a strong line of showers and storms will move through the area around midday Wednesday. High winds will be located near to the surface, so any shower and storm will be capable of damaging wind gusts. Stay aware of the weather throughout the day on Wednesday and plan any road travel around the storms.

Thursday and Friday look slightly below average for this time of year with high temps in the low to mid 50s and overnight lows in the mid-30s to low-40s. Saturday, our Rotary Gala Day, will be warm with temperatures in the upper 70s.
