

DisCon25 - District 7710 Conference Friday 05/16/2025



RCOR 7-Day Forecast

This week's rocky weather start will cause some lingering showers today, which will then give way to a pleasant few days before another round of showers and storms crosses the area Thursday. For today, a few showers will move through central NC as cooler air moves into the region. Overnight lows will drop close to freezing by sunrise Tuesday morning before temperatures warm into the low to mid-70s for highs on Tuesday and Wednesday. Another band of showers and storms will move through the region Thursday through Thursday evening bringing another round of cooler air in its wake. Skies will be mostly clear Friday through Sunday with high temperatures in the upper 60s to around 70F and overnight lows around 40F.
