## 2025 Scholarship Announcement

The Rotary Club of Hilton Head Island is again offering academic scholarships to graduating high school seniors. Scholarship awardees are eligible to receive scholarship funding of \$4,000 per year for a maximum of four years. Applicants must be residents of Hilton Head Island although they may attend off-island high schools.

The scholarship application is available on the following link: https://hiltonheadrotary.org (top right-hand corner). The scholarship application along with the requested attachments and uploads must be submitted no later than Monday, April 28, at 11:59 pm.

An applicant's potential for post-secondary success at a two- or four-year college or university is evaluated utilizing the following parameters:

- · Academic performance
- · Financial needs
- · Participation in school activities
- Community volunteer experience
- · Work experience (if applicable)
- · Letters of recommendation from two unrelated adults

Students planning to attend South Carolina colleges or universities receive preferential consideration.

## Hilton Head Island Rotary Club - United Way of the Low Country

#### **READ INDEED Program**

The Rotary Club of Hilton Head Island selected the United Way of the Low Country's READ INDEED program as our project to help improve literacy in our communities. We encourage Rotarian's interested in literacy and helping elementary students to improve their reading to sign up for this program as soon as possible to begin tutoring in January 2025.

A child learns to read until the fourth grade. After that, they read to learn. With the help of volunteer tutors, United Way of the Lowcountry's Early Grade Reading Initiative works with Pre-K through third-graders to help ensure children are prepared for success in school. Read Indeed! Offers one-on-one, in-person tutoring at the following schools on Hilton Head Island or Bluffton:

- Hilton Head School for Creative Arts
- · Red Cedar Elementary School, Bluffton

Volunteer as little as two hours a week during the school calendar year

Trained Read Indeed! Volunteer reading tutors are matched with children in grades Pre-K through third grade who are identified by school literacy specialists as needing additional help with reading. These are the students who would otherwise fall through the cracks if they did not receive other intervention.

- · Tutoring begins in October and January.
- Locations vary based on where tutors are needed,
- Morning or early afternoon hours are offered based on the student's availability and your schedule.
- · Each school's hours of operation vary.
- · Tutors receive training prior to and during the tutoring program. A background check is mandatory.
