Guest Speaker:

Coach Dave Esposito and his 3 captains were our program. His 3 captains (Antonios Aspras 157 pound state Champion, Jagger Rees 285 pound 3rd place, and Bennet Lane 126 pound 3rd place) were put on the spot with a series of questions from the Club members. For not having any script and not realizing that they were going to be the program speakers, these young men conducted themselves well. They related to us how their season went (they were 31-4 or something like that) and how the state tournaments went, the difficulties of being dedicated to a sport like that which demands "weigh-ins" twice (or more) per week, and how they get high school students to join the team. Coach Esposito also described how women's wrestling has been increasing in popularity in recent years and their team has women wrestlers in increasing numbers. Wrestling is the purest of sports. Just 2 competitors. No special equipment. On a flat mat. Both being roughly the same size and weight, and the better competitor wins. We get why they are so proud of their accomplishments. While these young men paid the personal price to excel at their sport, the fact that Foran Wrestling has now won three (3) State Championships is a testament to good (great?) coaching, which is harder in the modern era than it has ever been.
