Speaker:

Sue Brown was our speaker. She is the creator of Purple Pantry and she told us how it started and how it has developed over the last 5 years. The Rotary clubs in Milford, West Haven and Orange are working together to get a grant for \$10,000 to help support the Purple Pantry. There was a food drive on Saturday at Adam's Supermarket and there is a golf fund raiser coming up in May.

- The first Purple Pantry box was set up outside the Milford Courthouse. The goal of the boxes is to get food into the community in a barrier free fashion. There are a total of 19 boxes with 13 of them in Milford. They have helped other areas to build their own boxes but they don't fill boxes in other cities. Money from Milford stays in Milford. They are working on a home delivery system. They have found people may have homes but no money for food and sometimes no transportation to get food. Getting food is barrier free. Questions are asked to assess the need such as: How many people are you feeding daily? Where else can you get food? Do you have a car (to be able to go the food bank)? They distribute 20,000 pieces of food every month.
- They were able to get a commercial grade refrigerator from excess money left over from Rotary support. They also got a secondhand freezer. They have 40 volunteers and they are always looking for donations. They are growing slowly and trying to learn as they grow. The Milford Health department has a list of what Pantries are available and when.
