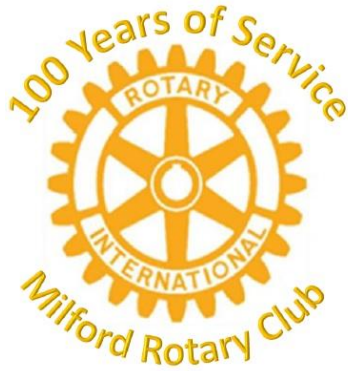


Milford Rotary Chat April 3, 2025
